Four arrested for kidnapping / unlawful imprisonment, two still wanted on same charges

Port Orchard, Wash. -- A 30 year-old Pierce County woman is unharmed and free after having been kidnapped and unlawfully held inside of an apartment. The woman managed to escape from the apartment early yesterday morning. She sought refuge and called 9-1-1.

Four suspects, two men and two women, have been taken into custody in connection with the woman's ordeal. A third man and a third woman are still outstanding. Warrants have been issued for their arrest.

Kitsap County Sheriff's patrol deputies responded to a convenience store at the intersection of Jackson Avenue SE & SE Lund Avenue, in South Kitsap, and contacted the hysterical victim. The woman alleged that she drove to the City of Bremerton to visit a friend Tuesday night. Upon reaching her destination, around 10:00 p.m., she was accosted by a male suspect and forced back into her vehicle. The suspect demanded that she drive to an apartment complex in South Kitsap.

Arriving at the Mariners' Glen Apartments she parked her vehicle and the car was surrounded immediately by other persons involved in her illegal detention. The victim claimed that she was forcefully removed from her vehicle and taken into an apartment where she was subjected to mental and physical abuse, threatened with a handgun and told that she was going to be held for ransom or shot.

The victim felt that she was going to be killed. The motive for the alleged kidnapping appears to be allegations of theft of money and / or controlled substances.

After being held for about 31 hours, the woman was able to escape from the apartment when her captors fell asleep.

Patrol deputies set containment on the apartment and telephoned inside. Four persons exited the apartment and were taken into custody. They were turned over to sheriff's detectives as the investigation continued. Detectives obtained a search warrant for the apartment and recovered handguns and ammunition.

The four suspects arrested out of the apartment were transported and booked into jail. They are scheduled to appear at 3:00 p.m. today in Kitsap County Superior Court on the following charges:

(1) **Terrell Scott Booker**, age 35, South Kitsap resident.

- Unlawful imprisonment
- Kidnapping, 1st degree
- Assault, 1st degree (deadly weapon)
- Unlawful possession of a firearm.

Total bail: \$525,000

(2) **Israel Adoram**, age 30, South Kitsap resident.

- Kidnapping, 1st degree
- Robbery, 1st degree
- Assault
- VUCSA: delivery of methamphetamine (arrest charge from a previous case)
- VUCSA: possession of methamphetamine (arrest charge from a previous case)

Total bail: \$500,000

(3) **Amanda Sue Fellingner**, age 29, South Kitsap resident.

- Unlawful imprisonment

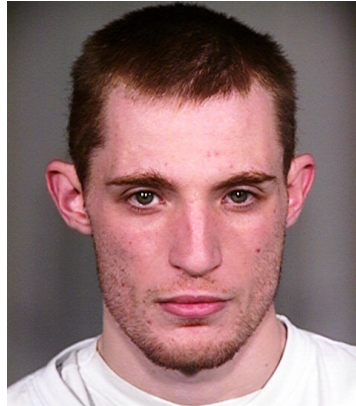
Bail: \$100,000

(4) **Megan Nicole Hopkins**, age 25, South Kitsap resident.

- Unlawful imprisonment.
